Today, these neighborhoods and communities, associated with a strong sense of Mexican and Latino American identity through art, culture, food, are facing severe displacement pressures. The activism and community development tradition are carried on by many residents and community-based organizations. We will explore real estate and development projects ranging across models and sizes on this LA East Side tour. This tour will be presented by Inclusive Action for the City, a Boyle Heights based economic development organization.
